PPS (Corporations and Other Amendments) Bill passed by the Senate

The Senate Committee tabled its report on the PPS (Corporations and Other Amendments) Bill 2010 on 12 May 2010, recommending that the Bill be passed. The House of Representatives passed the Bill the next day. The Bill was passed by the Senate on the 17 June 2010.

The end time for a registration for consumer property, or property described by a serial number is a nominated date no later than 7 years after the registration time. However, a registration can be renewed during the period it is registered. For further information see Table item 5 of subsection 153 (1) of the PPS Act 2010 which provides the relevant end dates for registrations on the PPS Register.
